





No picture.	Check channel has been selected correctly. If in multimedia state, change to TV state.
No sound.	Audio volume is off or the audio system has been improperly set.
Vague picture or unstable picture.	Ensure the antenna is correctly adjusted. The grounding signal is too weak.
Duplicated Pictures.	Reflective signals from nearby buildings or high reflective signals are being picked up.
Static interference.	Affected by electric wave interference from vehicle motors, trains, high-voltage power wires or neon lights.
No Colour.	Check colour is adjusted correctly. Poor signal. Check if the colour elimination function is on.
